KENHARDT COMES ON LINE

Kenhardt now has access to free wi-fi, funded by Aries Solar Power, which will help transform the town and make life easier for the whole community, including small businesses.

The service is accessible at a central community office, plus there are plans in place to expand to other locations once the area has more stable wireless and fibre services.

The project includes the installation of wi-fi infrastructure as well as free data for all community members, accessible at the offices of the Kenhardt Community Development Committee.

Vinknessie Kleuterskool, which provides educational and developmental support for Kenhardt's children, ages 3 to 6 years, has been upgraded to allow for double the number of children.

MORE BURSARY FUNDING FOR KENHARDT

Matriculants from the class of 2021 in the Kenhardt community, as well as students already studying, welcomed the opportunity to apply for the 2022 tertiary bursaries.

This is part of the Globeleq Scholarship Fund Scarce Skills Programme, which aims to develop skills that will most benefit and help develop this community. It covers tuition fees, travel and accommodation costs, book allowances and even a stipend.

The bursaries are for tertiary studies in the field of education, agriculture or nursing and are funded by Aries Solar Power's economic development programme.
